Dissemination Report for MARDS project

With a consortium consisting of 16 prestigious European partners such as the University of Vienna in Austria, the University of Montenegro, the University of Maribor in Slovenia, University of Zagreb in Croatia etc. and with a budget of over 870 thousand euros, Metropolitan Tirana University is part of this Erasmus+ project funded by the European Commission (Erasmus + Program, KA2 Capacity Building). The MARDS project will contribute in resolving and improving one of the actual problems of the Education System in Montenegro and Albania, related to the third cycle of studies, Doctorate Degree. The main objective is to reconsider the policy standards of the doctoral studies in these two countries in order to be in line with the Salzburg Principles and the best practices of the European Union.

Among the important objectives of this project, which is anticipated to last for three years, is the establishment of two joint Doctoral Schools Albania-Montenegro, respectively with profile "Natural sciences and Technology for Sustainable Development", located in Montenegro (Podgorica), as well as the Doctoral School with profile "Economy and Tourism for Sustainable Development" located in Albania (Shkodra), which will serve as an example of "good practice" for the Western Balkans region.

The project will assist academic staff and doctoral students to improve their performance by gaining adequate knowledge and skills from EU Partners, as well as will serve to build capacity and strengthen further collaborations in the scientific research field with relevant partners, part of the Consortium. Furthermore, will also help improve the development of sustainable methods of financing doctoral studies in these two countries. In the first year of the project's implementation, trainings of the academic staff coming from Albanian Universities and Universities of Montenegro were conducted to the partner Universities of the EU countries, from where the best experiences and models of organizing doctoral studies were gained and where the strong connection that these studies have with the businesses and the development of the economy of the respective Regions was mirrored.

In addition, it is important to mention that the Western Partners of EU in this project are European leaders in offering doctoral study programs such as the University of Vienna, University of Zagreb, University of Maribor and the University of Banska Bystrica which are also a guarantee for the quality of application that the University is preparing to complete.
